

CURRENT CYCLING SCHEMES

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

To inform the forum about the current cycling schemes being implemented, and schemes that are currently being planned

2. SUPPORTING INFORMATION

2.1 At the Local Access Forum meeting on 30th June 2014 a report was requested for this meeting to update the forum on the current cycling schemes being undertaken in the Borough.

2.2 Schemes currently underway

- A329 High Street, Ascot – shared use path on northern footway between Heatherwood roundabout and a point east of the racecourse entrance.
- Monkey Island Lane – signed quiet route for cyclists as an alternative to the sub-standard shared use path along the northern side of the A308 between Fifield and Maidenhead
- A308 Maidenhead Road, Windsor – widening the shared use path on the north side between Windsor Racecourse and Mill Lane
- Clewer Village to Windsor Town Centre – signing and lining improvements throughout the route and improving sight lines at the railway bridge
- Windsor Town Centre Environmental Enhancement – additional / relocation of existing cycle parking in William Street and Oxford Road East
- Windsor and Eton Riverside Station – cycle parking improvements

2.3 Planned new cycling schemes (subject to Cabinet Prioritisation Sub-Committee Approval)

- A4 Maidenhead to Slough Cycle Route – business case development
- Ascot to Windsor Cycle Route – feasibility study and business case development
- Stafferton Way, Maidenhead – toucan crossing
- Wells Lane, Ascot – surfacing improvements
- School Cycle Parking – Cookham Dean Primary School, Windsor Boys School (repair), Furze Platt Junior School, Furze Platt Senior School (extension)
