An open invitation has been issued to local residents and businesses to come along and hear all about the exciting developments so far in the rejuvenation of Maidenhead town centre.

Maidenhead Town Forum's meeting on **Wednesday 26 March** will turn the spotlight on the many and varied elements of the Town Centre 'jigsaw' and give everyone the opportunity to get an update on progress.

Cllr Philip Love, Forum Chairman and a member of PRoM (Partnership for the Rejuvenation of Maidenhead), explained: "The problem for many people is that although they can see bits and pieces going on, it's difficult to appreciate how it all fits together."

"The Town Forum is a great place to join up the dots! There are many exciting projects already achieved, in development or planned, and they all add up to some very good news indeed.

"The Town Forum meets totally in public, and by devoting an entire meeting to understand what's happening in the Town Centre – both now and in the future – we will give everyone a full picture and enable them to share the excitement."

The Maidenhead rejuvenation 'story' will be presented by Steph James, Town Manager, and Gail Kenyon, the Council's Planning Infrastructure and Regeneration Manager. Both are heavily involved in the Transforming Maidenhead campaign – run jointly by the Royal Borough and PRoM – to promote the Town and its commercial advantages to high level developers and investors.
