1 REPORT SUMMARY

- 1.1 This paper provides details of the RBWM 4-16 school funding formula for 2015-16. The formula was submitted to the Education Funding Agency (EFA) on 20 January 2015.
- 1.2 Formula allocations are based on the October 2014 pupil data and on the increased AWPU and deprivation rates which schools were consulted on in the Autumn 2014. The uplift in funding rates was made possible by the 3.2% increase in RBWM's DSG Schools Block Unit of Funding which the Government announced in July 2014 following their Fairer Funding Review. For RBWM, this increase was equivalent to around £2.5 million additional funding assuming no change in pupil numbers.
- 1.3 The paper summarises the key points from the 2015-16 funding formula.

2 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 That Schools Forum note the final 2015-16 funding formula allocations and rates set out in Annex A to this report and the individual school budget shares set out in Annex B.

3 DETAIL

- 3.1 On 31 October 2014 officers submitted the first draft of RBWM's proposed funding formula for 2015-16 to the EFA. The formula took account of the outcome of our consultation with schools in the autumn. The consultation asked for views on proposals for allocating approximately £2.5m additional funding to schools, mainly through an uplift to the AWPU and deprivation rates.
- 3.2 The October submission to the EFA was based on October 2013 pupil data and was confirmed as being compliant with School Finance Regulations.
- 3.3 We have now received finalised pupil data from the October 2014 school census which is used to populate the 2015-16 final formula.
- 3.4 The final funding formula was submitted to the EFA on 20 January 2015. The formula is the same as the October submission except for the changes in pupil data. The funding rates for each of the formula factors remain unchanged from those agreed following the autumn consultation and agreed with Schools Forum on 22 October.
- 3.5 The overall funding allocated through the final formula, the funding rates, and the pupil units are shown in **Annex A** with equivalent 2014-15 information for comparison. Individual budget shares are shown in **Annex B**. Note that the budgets for academy schools are indicative and reflect what those schools would receive if they were maintained schools. The EFA is responsible for calculating and notifying academies of

their final 2015/16 academic year budget allocations based on the RBWM formula. The purpose of including academies in the funding formula is to determine the amount of DSG funding that the EFA will 'recoup' from RBWM's allocation for academies.

3.6 The key points are:

- Funding allocated through the formula (including academies) has increased by £3.141 million, from £76.117m in 2014-15 to £79.258m in 2015-16.
- There are two main reasons for this increase 1) the uplift to AWPU and deprivation funding rates (£2.091m) as a result of RBWM's increase in the DSG School's Block per pupil rate and 2) an increase of 342 pupils and other pupil changes compared with October 2013 pupil data (£1.050m).
- The proportion of funding allocated through the Basic per Pupil Entitlement (line 17) is 79.83%, the same as last year, with a slightly higher proportion (+0.9%) allocated to primary pupils. Total funding allocated through the BPPE has increased by £2.463m.
- Funding allocated for deprivation has increased by £370k (14%). The proportion of funding allocated for deprivation (line 2) has increased from 3.54% to 3.86% as a result.
- The increase in lump sum allocations of £264k (line 7) mainly reflects the addition of the two new free schools Braywick Court and Holyport College.
- As a result of the additional funding allocated through the formula, only eight schools now receive funding protection through Minimum Funding Guarantee compared with 21 schools in 2014-15. The cost of protection has reduced by £359k, from £565k to £206k.
- As MFG protection is funded by gaining schools, this reduction in MFG means that schools
 which gain under the formula now keep more of their gain than previously. In 2014-15 gaining
 schools saw their gain capped at 2.32% per pupil. In 2015-16 the cap has increased to
 6.12%.
- The primary to secondary funding ratio remains in line with the national average at 1:1.27 (line 19). In 2014-15 the equivalent ratio was 1:1.28.
- 3.7 Individual indicative budget allocations will be sent to schools in early February with final budgets issued by 27 February 2015.
