## REPORT SUMMARY

Following the outcome of the local elections held on 2 May 2019, the Council has a duty under the Local Government and Housing Act 1989 to review and determine the representation of the different political groups on bodies appointed by the council.

## 1. DETAILS OF RECOMMENDATION(S)

RECOMMENDATION: That Full Council notes the report and:
i) Notes the political balance of the council as a result of the local elections held on 2 May 2019 as detailed in paragraph 2.1.
ii) Approves the membership of the committees, panels and forums for the ensuing Municipal Year as detailed in Appendix A.
iii) Appoints the Chairman and Vice-Chairman for the ensuing Municipal Year as detailed in Appendix A.
iv) Delegates authority to the Service Lead - Governance to amend/make further appointments on the nomination of the relevant Group Leader.
v) Delegates authority to the Monitoring Officer to amend the constitution as appropriate in light of any amendments to the structure of Panels, Committees and Forums as detailed in Appendix A, including:

- The number of panel members on the Licensing Panel be amended to 11 (see paragraph 2.7 for details)
- The inclusion of Old Windsor ward in the terms of reference for the Windsor Town Forum (see paragraph 2.8 for details)


## 2. REASON(S) FOR RECOMMENDATION(S) AND OPTIONS CONSIDERED

2.1 In accordance with Regulation 8 of the Local Government (Committees and Political Groups) Regulations 1990, Councillors have given notice to the Managing Director of their wish to be regarded as members of political groups. The number of seats held on the council is therefore as follows:

- Conservative: 23 seats
- Liberal Democrats: 9 seats
- Local Independents (West Windsor Residents' Association, Old Windsor Residents' Association and the Borough First): 8 seats
2.2 A political group for this purpose is a group of two or more members. Councillor Larcombe (National Flood Prevention Party) is the only councillor who is not a member of a political group.
2.3 The Council has a subsequent duty to review and determine the allocation of seats to political groups at its Annual meeting. The allocation of seats is determined by applying the political balance rules prescribed by Sections 15 and 16 of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989 and supplemented by the Local Government (Committees and Political Groups) Regulations 1990:

Seats on relevant committees must be allocated to different political groups so far as reasonably practicable in accordance with the following four principles:
(a) that not all the seats on the body are allocated to the same political group;
(b) that the majority of the seats on the body is allocated to a particular political group if the number of persons belonging to that group is a majority of the Council's membership;
(c) subject to paragraphs (a) and (b) above, that each political group is allocated the same proportion of the total seats across all the ordinary committees of the Council as the proportion of the members of the Council that belong to that group; and
(d) subject to paragraphs (a) to (c) above, that each political group is allocated the same proportion of the seats on each relevant body as the proportion of the members of the Council that belong to that group
2.4 The Council's overriding duty to comply with (a) and (b) above takes precedence over achieving a mathematically balanced distribution of seats as described in (c) and (d). Applying those rules the table below sets out the allocation of seats:

2.5 The rules are designed to ensure that the political composition of the Council's panels, committees and forums as far as possible replicates the political composition of Full Council. The Council therefore has a duty to make appointments to those bodies giving effect to the wishes of the political group allocated the seats.
2.6 Council could, if it so resolved by a resolution with no Member voting against the resolution, depart from the proportionality rules as detailed above.
2.7 The political balance rules do not apply to the Health and Wellbeing Board, in accordance with the Local Authority (Public Health, Health and Wellbeing Boards and Health Scrutiny) Regulations 2013. The terms of reference for the board require three councillors to be appointed, to include Lead Member(s) with responsibility for Adult and Children's Services. Members are asked to also make the appointments to the Health and Wellbeing Board as detailed in Appendix A.
2.8 The Council is also required to appoint the Chairmen and Vice-Chairmen to each body, with the exception the Overview and Scrutiny Panels which shall select a Chairman and Vice Chairman for the ensuing municipal year from their respective memberships at the first meeting of each Panel. The proposed Chairman and Vice Chairman appointments are detailed in Appendix A.
2.9 Given the reduction in the number of overall Members of the Council to 41 from May 2019, it is proposed that the number of Members on the Licensing Panel be reduced from 15 to 11 .
2.10 It is proposed that Old Windsor Ward be added to the terms of reference for the Windsor Town Forum, to reflect the fact that some central Windsor areas previously covered by the forum, including Home Park and the Boltons, are now located in the ward. The terms of reference would be amended to read:

- Windsor Town Forum covering issues concerning the following wards:
> Clewer \& Dedworth East
$>$ Clewer \& Dedworth West
$>$ Clewer East
> Eton \& Castle
$>$ Old Windsor
