### Residential Burglary

Windsor Central - 7 reported with 1 having a suspect. 2019 (8 reports)

Windsor East - 15 reported with none having a suspect or suspects. 2019 (15 reports)

Windsor West - 15 reported with 1 having a suspect. 2019 (21 reports)

### Theft from Motor Vehicle

Windsor Central - 13 reported with none having a suspect or suspects. 2019 (24 reports)

Windsor East- 16 reported with none having a suspect or suspects. 2019 (26 reports)

Windsor West- 11 with none having a suspect or suspects. 2019 (16 reports)

#### Theft or unauthorised taking of a pedal cycle

Windsor Central - 4 reported with none having a suspect or suspects. 2019 (16 reported)

Windsor East - 1 reported with none having a suspect or suspects. 2019 (0 reported)

Windsor West - 8 reported with 1 having a suspect. 2019 (2 reported)

#### **Drug Offences**

**Windsor Central** - 12 reports, with all having a suspect that were either dealt with by arrest or community resolution. 2019 (20 reports)

**Windsor East** - 7 reports, with all having a suspect that were either dealt with by arrest or community resolution. 2019 (1 reports)

**Windsor West** - 15 reports with all having a suspect that were either dealt with by arrest or community resolution. 2019 (12 reports)
