LLFA Duties & Responsibilities

- Flood and Water Management Act

Lead Local Flood Authority

- Duty to co-operate with other public bodies to manage flood risk in the borough and across boundaries
- Local Flood Risk Management Strategy
- Duty to Investigate Flood Incidents
- Register of structures or features which have an affect on flood risk
- Consenting and enforcement powers for ordinary watercourses
- Statutory consultee for surface water drainage for major development (SUDS)

RBWM as Highway Authority

- Maintain highways, including ensuring that highway drainage systems are clear
- Deliver works necessary to protect the highway from flooding, and direct runoff away from properties

Environment Agency

- National strategic role
 - Thames Regional Flood and Coastal Committee
- Local operational role
 - Emergency planning
 - Statutory consultee for planning applications in areas at risk of flooding and major applications
 - Main Rivers
 - Reservoirs

Thames Water

- Maintain the public sewer system to ensure that their areas are effectually drained
- Respond to flooding incidents involving their assets
