All reports are from the 26/05/2021 to 11/07/2021.

Just to clarify that for police recording purposes a residential burglary does include out buildings i.e garages and sheds.

Finally at the end of each line is the figure for the corresponding time period last year for the number of reports received by the police.

Figures

Residential Burglary

Windsor Central- 4 reported with one suspect to date. 2020(7 reports)

The trend for Windsor Central in this period in time is a garage breaks.

Windsor East- 1 reported with no suspects to date. 2020(12 reports)

The break down for East is 1 attempt where no entry was gained.

Windsor West- 4 reported with 1 having a suspect. 2020(7 reports)

West have seen 2 house breaks and 2 attempts.

Theft from Motor Vehicle

Windsor Central - 3 reported with no suspects suspect. 2020(13 reports)

1 catalytic converter, 1 number plate and items stolen a vehicle left unlocked.

Windsor East- 2 reports. 2020(9 reports)

1 number plates and second locked vehicle but no sign of break?

Windsor West- 10 reported with no suspects.2020 (13 reports)

The trend is vans with tools being stolen.

Business Burglary

Windsor Central- 1 reported with no suspects. 2020(1 reported)

Windsor East- No reported offences. 2020(0 reported)

Windsor West- 1 reported with no suspects. 2020(1 reported)

Wildlife crime

The Windsor and Maidenhead police area have had 6 reports of wildlife crime in this period.

Illegal fishing, the shooting of squirrels with an air gun, ill treatment of a hedgehog and possible poisoning of animals. All are being investigated at this time.
