CRIME STATS FOR MAIDENHEAD FOR THE LAST 31 DAYS - 03 09 2021

BURGLARY DWELLINGS:

WARNING – Police record garage breaks of integrated garages to a house as a burglary dwelling. These have been removed from the figures as have – Burglaries involving domestic cases, parties where items go missing, shared accommodation where items go missing from shared rooms, landlord and tenant – and cases where it is believed the aggrieved is suffering from mental impairment, duplicate entries (2 people report the same offence) or people change their minds (people report missing items from their home as burglaries, but later find them).

The computer shows 15 Domestic burglaries recorded – but only 5 were actual burglaries

29/7 School Lane Cookham – house under renovation – tools stolen

31/7 Sheephouse Road – Forced door while owners away. Jewellery stolen

31/7 – 6/8 Farm Road – Rear kitchen window opened by unknown means – Asian gold jewellery stolen

15/8 – Harrow Lane – Possible attempted burglary – owner disturbed someone at the front door with keys, who walked away. No entry gained and nothing stolen.
