CRIME STATS FOR WINDSOR FOR THE LAST 31 DAYS to 16 05 2022

BURGLARY DWELLINGS:

WARNING – Police record garage breaks of integrated garages to a house as a burglary dwelling. These have been removed from the figures as have – Burglaries involving domestic cases, - parties where items go missing, - shared accommodation, where items go missing from shared rooms, - landlord and tenant – and cases where it is believed the aggrieved is suffering from mental impairment.

The police computer shows 8 burglaries recorded. 6 real burglaries, 1 known suspect and 1 domestic related

23/4 **Vansittart Road**. Abandoned building – vandalism recorded as burglary 28/4 **Wolf Lane**. Burglary in progress. Two people seen in rear garden. Aggrieved phoned the police then the alarm sounded and they made off. No entry gained and nothing stolen.

2/5 **Grange Road, Wraysbury**. Burglary in progress. Offender entered the property via an open rear door and pushed the elderly resident asking for their wallet. Aggrieved pressed her Pendant to call the police and offender made off. Nothing stolen.

2/5 **Old Ferry Drive, Wraysbury**. Distraction Burglary. Man cold called and distracted the elderly victim to get her out of the house, while an accomplice went in and stole a purse. May be connected to the job above.

7/5 London Road, Datchet. Aggrieved about to move into new house. Tools keys and other items stolen. Other items moved about with some vandalism.

14/5 Town gate lodge, Datchet Road. Temporary accommodation for Horse Show participants. One team had belongings searched and items stolen.
