

Footfall – Headline data - week to 29 October

The total number of visitors to Windsor Town Centre External for the last 52 weeks is 7,365,866 which is 3.5% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors for the year to date is 6,158,628 which is 3.9% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to Windsor Town Centre External in week commencing 23 October 2023 was 139,474.

The busiest day in week commencing 23 October 2023 was Saturday with 22,293 visitors.

The peak hour of the week was 15:00 on Sunday 29 October 2023 with footfall of 3,270.

Car & Coach Parking - July

Car parking for Sept has decrease 40% (56523 users compared to last year (94295). It should be noted that we normally would see a decrease this time of year as the summer holidays come to an end but also we have seen some very poor weather.

Whilst overall car parking has seen a reduction the coach park saw a significant increase in users in September of 120% (1311 users) compared to the (595 users) same period last year


