1. SUMMARY

1.1 National Highways in their recent response dated 19/12/2023 requested specific drainage related documents to demonstrate that additional surface water runoff from development would not be a risk to its assets (A404).

It is recommended the committee grants planning permission with the conditions listed in Section 14 of the main report with the additional condition in Section 3 below.

2. Comments from Consultees

2.1 Recent response from National Highways dated 19/12/2023.

National Highways (NH) The applicant needs to provide NH with details of the soakaway, design, dimensions including infiltration testing and ground investigation to understand whether additional run off would not be a risk to its assets (A404). They advise that all surface water will need to be contained and discharged from within the red line (property) boundary.
