# Introduction

- **The Family Hub Service was launched on 1st May 2021 to replace Children's Centres, Youth Service, Family Resilience and Parenting**
- **The FH sits within Early Help but will support children, young people and families on statutory plans inc Children in Care**
- **A majority of staff are divided into 2 main hubs (Windsor and Maidenhead) and there is also the Families Together Team and the small Boroughwide Team**
- **The work is focussed on supporting targeted families across the age range of 0-19 years (or age 25 years where young people have learning difficulties and/or disabilities or a care leaver)**
