The total number of visitors for the year to date is 891,402 which is 5.5% down on the previous year.


The total number of visitors to Windsor Town Centre External in month commencing 29 January 2024 was 463,741.

The busiest day in month commencing 29 January 2024 was Saturday 17 February with 27,107 visitors.

The peak hour of the month was 14:00 on Sunday 18 February 2024 with footfall of 3,940.

Car & Coach Parking – Upto January 2024

At the end of January car parking usage showed a decrease year on year of 9% from 67675 users down to 61525.

Coach parking usage over the same period has continued to increase with user number for January reaching 622 users, a 74% increase on 2023. Usage of the coach park has generally been very positive throughout the year.






