

Security & Dispersal (inc related)

The aim of The Boom's Security policy is to promote the 4 licensing objectives and go further than required to ensure its compliance.

Any door supervisors on duty at the premises must be supplied by an SIA-Approved Contractor Scheme company

The premises licence holder shall ensure that the provision of door supervisors at the premises is appropriate to ensure the safe control of the premises, and shall review this on a regular basis

Despite the Boom's licence requirements to only have two door staff, (at given times), the following shall be used as a guide to deployment:

Thursdays	2 door staff shall be used. One to start at 21.00 hours until close and the other at 21.30 hours until close.
Friday	A minimum of 3 door staff to be used. One at 21.00 hours until close and the others at 21.30 hours until close. On busier times of the month i.e.: pay weekends or public holidays 4 door staff to be employed.
Saturdays	A minimum of 4 door staff to be used. One at 21.00 hours until close and 3 at 21.30 hours until close. At the behest of the manager a 5 th member can be employed if they expect a busier night.
Sunday	2 door staff shall be used. One at 21.00 hours until close and the other at 21.30 hours until close.
All other times	Private functions will be judged on merit and door staff will be employed accordingly to promote the four licensing objectives.

Any queue to enter the premises that forms outside the premises shall be kept orderly and supervised by licensed door supervisors to ensure that there is no public nuisance or obstruction to the public highway

Any person who appears to be intoxicated or who is behaving in a disorderly manner shall not be allowed entry to the premises. A zero-tolerance policy should be implemented regarding the use of illegal drugs on the premises.

IDSCAN is operated at the premises. All persons entering the premises must provide verifiable ID and record their details on the system. It is unlawful for children to attempt to buy alcohol just as it is unlawful to sell or supply alcohol to them. To prevent such crimes, our scanning policy is applied requiring the production of "proof of age" before entry to the premises. This item is not enforced by The Boom's licence but is at the choice of the management to enhance safety and promote the four licensing objectives.

A town link radio contract has been entered into and shall be used by the manager or SIA trained door staff on any occasion the premises are open to the public.

The premises have installed and maintain a comprehensive digital [colour] CCTV system. All public areas of the licensed premises, including all public entry and exit points, and the street environment will be covered, enabling facial identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV cameras shall continually record while the premises are open to the public and recording shall be kept available and unedited for a minimum of 30 days with the date and time stamping. A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be present on the premises at all times when they are open to the public and must be able to produce/download/ burn CCTV images upon request by a police officer or an authorised officer of the licensing authority. Any footage must be in a format that can be played back on a standard personal computer or standard DVD player.

A TV monitor shall be positioned at the entrance to the premises, showing live footage of persons entering and leaving

Staff shall monitor customers smoking outside the premises on a regular basis and ensure patrons do not cause a public nuisance.

Patrons permitted to temporarily leave and then re-enter the premises, eg. To smoke shall not be permitted to take drinks or glass containers with them.

Door staff will be placed in strategic positions within the club to ensure best possible coverage and visibility. All door staff to display their SIA badge with a high visibility holder, clearly visible to patrons. Staff must exercise a full duty of care during operating hours to all patrons and staff alike.

Dispersal at close

The role of door supervisors in managing persons leaving

Two door staff to position themselves internally at the back of the club at closing in order to encourage customers to depart the premises in an orderly fashion. All customers are to leave via the front entrance. Under no circumstances should customers be allowed to exit from the back doors. One Door staff member to position himself in the middle of the front bar and ensure continued flow towards exit. As the back bar is cleared, one door staff member to check toilets then return to front door. As all patrons are departing all available door staff to be at front door to encourage quiet dispersal. All door staff to remain at front until crowd has dispersed in the main.

It is the responsibility of ALL staff to remind the patrons to leave in a quiet and orderly fashion. ALL staff should remind patrons to be respectful to neighbours at all times. The role of door supervisors in ensuring effective dispersal of patrons from the premises at the end of the night – Door supervisors should be instructed to encourage persons leaving the premises to do so without causing disturbance and in an orderly fashion.

All policy should have in mind at all times the four licensing objectives.

Nature of Incident - what happened?

The aggrieved is a previous manager and was out with friends at Fuzzy Bear when he intervened in a dispute between door staff and the offenders who were upset that they could not check the bar for a missing mobile phone. They were asked to come back when the club had closed so a proper search could be made. Aggd tried to calm suspects down but was punched to the head and fell to the ground unconscious. Aggd has a second head injury which maybe from the fall or a second punch. There is no CCTV - LV to far and Fuzzy Bear was just out of footprint. Boom bar was due to be checked by ET as a follow up enquiry (they had shut by the time officers had dealt with the scene). Offenders ran off and were picked up by LV in Bachelors Acre. Offenders split up and 1 was arrested shortly after being sighted. The second went garden hopping and was retrieved from a garden after breaking his ankle when falling from a fence. Occupants were woken by police and the suspect arrested. Suspect assaulted PC 836 Rowbottom (CA Team 2) who had ? fractured elbow but xray confirmed badly bruised. (John will be on lights for a little while and welfare support has been provided).

Boom Bar - Could have checked CCTV for us but closed while officers on scene.
Fuzzy Bear - staff really helpful allowing aggd and witnesses to be debriefed in their bar after it had closed. They then took witness (staff) home. They offered to come back in early AM for CCTV and scanner search once we had description/name for suspect

Nature of Incident - what happened?

A large fight outside Boom Bar on Goswell Hill. Goswell Hill was extremely busy with people outside clubs, particularly around the pinch point by Scotch and Boom Bar. The group were mostly male and the atmosphere was tetchy. Suddenly and without warning or build up a fight broke out. LV asked for police support over the townlink radio. The fight was centered outside Boom Bar while other fights broke out down hill from the start location. A significant police response was required to restore order. 4 police officers were assaulted. At least 1 door staff was assaulted (ABH) and others may have been injured during control and restraint of people fighting. One offender was taken to hospital with a broken ankle. The level of violence this man showed was excessive.

Premises Response - what part did staff play? How did they react/assist (include good/door performance)?

I was first on scene and was taken by doorstaff (name UK) from the parking area at the bottom of the hill through the crowd to outside Boom Bar. The crowd was angry and would not give way as we walked through. The door staff held onto me to ensure we did not get separated. Outside Boom Bar 4 door staff were restraining two males on the floor. For both males the restraint was similar with one door staff restraining the subject's ankles by laying across the lower legs and another restraining the arms and head by leaning across the upper back and shoulders. Both subjects were actively resisting despite the restraint. A door staff from Scotch (known to me but, I cannot remember his name) approached me while holding a dressing to a 3-4 " laceration above his left eye which was actively bleeding. He said he had been assaulted and I asked him to take me to the offender which he did. The offender was immediately violent, assaulting me and my colleague who arrived moments later by punching and kicking. I was aware that door staff were trying to intervene, but at that point the incident had escalated considerably and I was concentrating on the subject himself. I was not aware of any further involvement from door staff.

I did see door staff from Vanilla outside Boom Bar helping with dispersing the crowd. This was early during the incident. They had come down Goswell Hill to help.

Police Response - what action was taken? Please identify the main officers who dealt with the incident.

I was the first officer and first Sgt on scene. I was monitoring the crowd dynamics from the bottom of Goswell Hill. the call from LV confirmed a large fight. I asked for units on immediate. I assessed the situation outside Boom Bar: 2 subjects actively resisting but being restrained by door staff. A large, angry and very intoxicated crowd which was comprised mostly of young men that was on the tipping point of immediate further disorder. One of the door staff who had been assaulted took me to the suspect and identified him. I asked the male if he was ok and he responded immediately with assaultive resistance, punching and kicking me. I did not see the subject's ankle because it was covered in clothing or a blanket. When he started kicking I saw the ankle was deformed. Distraction blows to the upper arm did not have any effect, neither did CS Spray. Support arrived and brought the suspect to a nearby police van to wait for ambo. Ambo did not despatch and waiting increased the disorder. I was stood down at this point for welfare debrief. I am an experienced NTE supervisor and I have not seen violence on such a scale or intensity before on Goswell Hill.

Nature of Incident - what happened?

At 0138hrs my colleague and I responded to an assistance call from Nightsafe Officers on GOSWELL HILL, WINDSOR. They stated that there was an altercation outside the ZOOM Bar (although I believe the correct name of the premise is the BOOM BOOM bar) involving 3 males and door staff and that there was an injured party with a broken ankle. Upon attending the scene I went up GOSWELL HILL from the service tunnel and in the mouth of an used railway arch, I believe it is the one to the left of the BOOM BOOM bar, a male was being restrained on the floor by 2/3 Officers, one of these being PS 4465 PARKER. At this point I believe that the other 2 males mentioned in the initial assistance call had already be arrested and placed in Police Vehicles.

Premises Response - what part did staff play? How did they react/assist (include good/poor performance)?

The Officers were struggling to restrain the male and appeared unable to handcuff him due to this. Around them there was a large crowd who were shouting and swearing at the Officers who were on the ground and standing directly over them. Included in this crowd was a large IC3 male who was wearing all black and appeared to me to be a member of doorstaff although I am unsure from which establishment. with the proximty of the crowd to the Officers and DP I was concerned that for the safety of the DP and the Officers, I therefore began to tell individuals in the crowd to get back whilst having to physical push some back as they did not react to my direction. This is when my attention was drawn to the IC3 male who standing very close to the Officers with his back to the crowd. I told him to stand back and he shouted words to the effect of 'ITS OUT OF ORDER' and 'THEY DIDN'T NEED TO SPRAY HIM'. I had to tell him to get back on several occasions and it is at this point that I formed the opinion that this male was a member of doorstaff due to his dress. After moving the crowd back I decided that it would be best to remove the detained male to a more steril loction at the bottom of the hill where Officers could work more safely. Upon handcuffing the man and getting the male to his feet I became aware that he was the male with the broken ankle. Due to the hostility of the crowd I still believed it necessary to remove the male to the bottom of the hill and with another officer I carried to to Police vehilces there.

The male who I believed to be a member of doorstaff I would describe as being a black male, around 6'2" tall with a large chubby build. He appeared to be aged in his forties and was wearing black trousers, a black short sleeved shirt which I believe may have had a logo on the left side of the chest. His behaviour rather than helping the situation appeared to be inflaming it leaving the Officers and detained male very vulnerable on the ground.

Police Response - what action was taken? Please identify the main officers who dealt with the incident

Whilst waiting for an ambulance it was necessary to deploy up to 20 Officers to form a cordon around the male. A similar crowd developed around this cordon and for the around hour and a half it took for an ambulance to arrive it was necessary to deal with this crowd who were shouting and swearing at Police.

The behaviour of this crowd was very irratic, some were clearly very drunk, others did not appeared to be under the influence of alcohol but were acting in a way that led me to believe they were under the influence of drugs. This included several males who stated that they were with the DP and the DP himself who despite having a bad fracture of his ankle continued to spit, kick out (with his good and bad leg) and swear at Officers and the arriving Ambo crew.

Nature of Incident – what happened?

Report of a fight in progress on GOSWEL HILL, WINDSOR outside several of the bars. Upon my arrival three males had been detained by door staff and were face down on the floor. I along with other officers removed these males from the control of the door staff, handcuffed them and walked them out of the crowds and towards marked police vehicles which were parked at the bottom of GOSWELL HILL. An officer then activated their emergency button requesting immediate assistance outside CHARLEYS HORSE. I rushed to the officers aid and found PS PARKER and another officer restraining a male on the floor who had a broken ankle but was still resisting and lashing out at officers. They were surrounded by a large group of people including members of door staff all of whom were trying to obstruct the officers. I moved into the crowd and began pushing people back, one male whom I believe may have been a member of door staff from CHARLEYS HORSE was refusing to move back. I do not know his name or any other details however I can recall he was a black male of a very large build with a beard. He was dressed all in black with a black Puffa jacket and an SIA licence on his left arm. He was uncooperative and was not aiding officers in diffusing a very volatile situation where officers were greatly outnumbered.

Premises Response – what part did staff play? How did they react/assist (include good/poor performance)?

Officers were heavily outnumbered and dealing with a very uncooperative crowd who were trying to interfere and obstruct officers who were trying to detain a violent male who has sustained a severe injury to his ankle. Door staff on the whole (it's not possible to establish identities and from which premises) were unsupportive of officers present. I understand that once officers gained control of the situation and sufficient resources were on scene door staff were not very forthcoming with information as to what sparked off the incident in the first place.

Police Response – what action was taken? Please identify the main officers who dealt with the incident.

Four officers were assaulted during the incident and two males were arrested with one being charged for assault police. There were a large number of officers invovled in the incident. Nature of Incident - what happened?

On the above date at about 0135hours I heard PS 4465 PARKER update on the radio that GOSWELL HILL outside of the bar BOOM BAR that there was a mass gathering of people and that she required more officers as there was a lot of verbal arguments. She updated again very shortly that door staff on GOSWELL HILL outside of BOOM BAR had detained three people. After this almost immediately PS PARKER had activated her assistance button which is a "00" call which means that she required immediate assistance from other police colleagues. It was established that x3 males had been ejected from a club/bar from one of the premises on GOSWELL HILL, I am unaware of which bar. They had been detained by door staff, police have arrived and I believe PS PARKER was first on scene. She was met by a very hostile situation which resulted in captor being deployed. One of the males who was detained by for staff had an ankle broken as a result of being detained by door staff, however due to the very hostile situation this male was also captured. This males group of friends which I believed was about 50-60 had informed the opinion that the police have broken this males ankle. This then resulted in an even more hostile reception to all officers who attended the scene.

The group of friends dynamics where made up of a mixture of males and females, all about 20-25years old, Asian, mixed race, black and white. All of the group were very hostile towards the police as they believed we had broken their friends ankle. They did not become physically violent or aggressive towards us but were very verbally and active resistance so much so that we had to push few of the group back. This group took to their mobile phones to video record the police and started to argue. The main theme from the group was that people did not trust the police because of situations like this and therefore nobody likes the police.

My other colleagues and I placed on a cordon at the bottom of GOSWELL HILL next to the tunnel that leads towards BRIDGE WATER TERRACE. There was a grid lock of traffic due to a mixture of members of the public wanting to see what had occurred due to the high number of police presence and the taxis which belong to the rank who had parked inappropriately which made it very difficult for normal traffic and foot traffic to move on and most importantly hindering the access route for emergency services such as the ambulance and police. The taxis wanted to obtain fares from the crowd of the members of the public that were on looking however I managed to get the taxis to move on and pick up fares further down the slip road. Once one taxi moved on then the rest did follow this process and ultimately freed up access.

As I was stood on the cordon one of the door staff who I described as a black male, large build about 6ft tall, bald head and a black long beard saying to one of my colleagues but I do not know who say words similar to "I TOLD YOUR COLLEAGUE THAT THIS GUY HAD A BROKEN ANKLE AND GUESS WHAT, SHE WENT UP TO HIM AND SHE SPRAYED HIM IN THE FACE, I HAVE BEEN DOING THIS A LONG TIME AND I HAVE NEVER SEEN THIS TYPE OF POLICE SERVICE, THIS IS WHY PEOPLE HATE YOU, YOUR GETTING WORSE". This bouncer then stormed off. I could not obtained his details as I was on the cordon and I believe I have seen him working as door staff at CHARLIES HORSE on GOSWELL HILL.

Premises Response - what part did staff play? How did they react/assist (include good/poor performance)?

unknown what premise responded and how, however as mentioned above there was a door staff from Charlies Horse who came upto the police to verbally abuse police and stormed off. This did not help the situation as this provided "fuel" for the very hostile crowd. The rest of the club/bars on GOSWELL HILL did not offer any assistance and as this incident was very close to closing time for them, there was even more foot traffic. The club/bars did not direct these people to take alternative route to avoid the situation at the bottom of the hill and could have easily directed them towards the top, this would have eased some pressure on the officers dealing as we now had on lookers who wanted to film, argue and enter the cordoned off area.

We attended the venue to update and discuss the recent Gen40 reports of intoxication levels. See Gen 40's dated 21/06/18 and the 01/07/18. A positive Gen 40 dated 30/06/18 was also read out, which was in relation to the assistance of their door staff member following a GBH. Door staff member was very helpful to the Police Officers.

General discussion on intoxication levels took place and Barry informed us that they do monitor their customers inside the venue and door staff are also observing the customers throughout the evening. They do refuse to serve customers who have had enough to drink and they do try to keep the groups together, so no-one is left vulnerable.

The following was suggested and agreed:

Breathalyser to be used at the venue - (Barry did state that they do use the one next door sometimes)

Any refusals of intoxicated customers to be entered in the Incident Register

Any ejections of intoxicated customers to be relayed over the Retail Radio

PC Horsley then discussed the incident along Goswell Hill during the early hours of Saturday 7th July 2018, whereby a male is suspected to have broken his ankle and 3 Officers were assaulted (see occurrence 43180206726). The whole incident was a worrying incident and Officers were called to support as the crowd was very hostile and aggressive towards Officers.

Barry informed us that the male with the broken ankle who had to be captured and restrained by Officers as far as he was aware had not been in the Boom Bar.

We then had a general discussion policing and dispersal at the end of the evening. The venue is very co-operative and keen to work with the Police and Local Authority.

Barry did state that they were looking to extend the hours of the venue and this may help the dispersal at the end of the night as most of the venues all disperse at the same time.

Nature of Incident – what happened?	
<p>Tasked observations of Goswell Hill Friday Friday evening was a typical evening with a younger crowd using the clubs and bars. Some Security staff reported older customers who had come from the event at Windsor Racecourse. Vanilla was closed and this stopped the crowd that gathers in the area opposite their entrance which is used as a smoking area. There was congestion around Scotch and Boom bars at the pinch point. This congestion was consistent through both evenings. This area is operationally difficult to supervise and tactically difficult to manage incidents in. The main cause is customers coming out of the clubs to use Goswell Hill as a smoking area. They are in a confined space which raises tensions, particularly between young men and makes female customers more vulnerable. Neither are generally aware of their surroundings other than the person immediately next to them. All are affected by alcohol. SIA staff helped with the dispersal as far as the end of their respective bar outside area. Clubs on the pinch point shut their doors leaving a number of customers still to disperse.</p>

<p>Tasked observations of Goswell Hill Saturday. An older crowd who were joined by people who had left the T-Party. The area had a tetchy vibe. Vanilla was open so customers were using the area opposite for smoking. The pinch point at Scotch and Boom Bars was congested throughout the evening. SIA staff assisted as per Friday with the addition of much more proactive staff from Vanilla who helped with the dispersal right down to the taxi rankk</p>	

Police Response – what action was taken? Please identify the main officers who dealt with the incident	
<p>Taxi Marshalls - Goswell Hill We need taxis in numbers to get customers away at dispersal. Taxi drivers put up with a lot of bad behaviour from customers and they need our support. Staff are present but it is not clear who they are and what they do. Clear signage re pricing and who the taxis are would help. UBER and RBWM taxis do not mix well. Generally drivers are quick to pick up customers and get them away. They are delayed by customers who are drunk and haggling over the price. Better marking for taxi waiting would be helpful and may reduce the number of taxis just waiting in the service road which causes congestion and difficulties for delivery lorries.</p>
