

CRIME STATS FOR MAIDENHEAD FOR THE LAST 31 DAYS – 10 05 2022

BURGLARY DWELLINGS:

WARNING – Police record garage breaks of integrated garages to a house as a burglary dwelling. These have been removed from the figures as have – Burglaries involving domestic cases, parties where items go missing, shared accommodation where items go missing from shared rooms, landlord and tenant – and cases where it is believed the aggrieved is suffering from mental impairment.

The computer shows 14 Domestic burglaries recorded – but only 6 were actual burglaries / attempted burglaries

25/4 Winter Hill Road. PCSO out on patrol found a sit on mower in a ditch in Bigfrith Lane and found a house with its windows forced open. Investigated houses nearby and found one with its windows open. Currently unoccupied as owner died. 2 bottle of Champagne drunk and a handrail ripped from the wall.

28/4 Bray Road. Attempted burglary – marks found on front door. No entry gained and nothing stolen.

27/4 – 28/4 Ray Mill Road East. Side fence pulled down to access garden and summer house, full services.

28/4 – 29/4 Highfield Lane. Attempted burglary outside latch on door forced. No entry gained and nothing stolen.

6/5 Edinburgh Road. Possible burglary - cat and 2 kittens stolen. Aggrieved believes she knows who has done this.

6/5 Cannon Court Road. The owner found a note in his kitchen – ‘Hello, I have been inside ur house’. Several strange incidents before this. Possibly offender known to the aggrieved.

THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLES – INCLUDING VEHICLE INTERFERENCE:

The computer shows 18 offences recorded Only 12 were ‘theft froms’:

9/4 The Wickets. **CAR ENTERED BY UNKNOWN MEANS** – Video footage of man opening the boot and searching car – sunglasses and loose change stolen.

21/3 – 10/4 Norden Road. **CAR ENTERED BY UNKNOWN MEANS** - Children’s set of golf clubs stolen.

18/4 Clare Road. **CAR ENTERED BY UNKNOWN MEANS** – 2 men chased off – loose change stolen.

23/4 – 25/4 York Road. **CAR ENTERED BY UNKNOWN MEANS** – Raincoat, briefcase & puffa jacket stolen.

28/4 – 29/4 Bray Road. **CAR ENTERED BY UNKNOWN MEANS** - 2nd time in 2 weeks. Car searched. Nothing stolen.

28/4 Chantry Road. **CAR ENTERED BY UNKNOWN MEANS** – car searched – nothing stolen.

28/4 Chiltern Road. Reports X 2 of a man walking along the road trying car door handles.

27/4 Newbury Drive. Doorbell footage of an offender trying to break into a car. Man arrested.

20/4 – 24/4 Ray Lea Close. Red Alpha Romeo GTV stolen

29/4 Bath Road. A grey Vauxhall Grandland X SRI involved in collision and left parked up stolen.

4/5 Fishery Road. Grey Land Rover Sport stolen

5/5 Evenlode. Black Mercedes C350 Sport E stolen

29/4 – 3/5 Abercrombie Road. Black Ford Smax titanium Sport stolen

8/5 – 9/5 Fishery Road. Black Land Rover Velar stolen

THEFT OF BIKES:

8 offences recorded. These are the figures for theft of bikes from roads. Those stolen from sheds and garages are not included.
