Only a small section of the Jubilee River passes through the borough and according to our records, the structures for which RBWM are wholly responsible for are:

- 2610 BLACK POTTS FOOTBRIDGE
- 2453 POCOCKS LANE
- 2756 THE MYRKE FOOTBRIDGE (aka MICHAELS BRIDGE)
